

Important Coach's Information

- Draft:** The draft will be held prior to the coaches meeting at the Community Service Portable.
- Pre-K – 2nd: Teams will be randomly selected and children will be placed on teams within their division by gender and grade
- 3rd & 4th: Teams will be randomly selected and children will be placed on teams within their division by gender, grade and campus (when possible).
- 5th & 6th: Teams will be randomly selected and children will be placed on teams within their division by gender, grade, campus (when possible), and rank (Ranking 1 to 5 (5 being the best), provided by student's Physical Education teacher).
- Coach's Meeting:** A mandatory coach's meeting will be held at the BISD Board Room, 906 Farm St. on Wednesday, January 13th starting at 6:00 PM. If you are going to coach you MUST attend this meeting or send a representative in your place.
- Practices:** Practices will begin on January 18th. Practices are an hour long
- Games:** Saturdays in January, February & March
1st Game: Saturday, January 30th
- Picture Day:** Saturday, February 20th (schedules will be distributed to coaches)
- Closing Ceremonies:** Each coach will be given awards to hand out to their team at the conclusion of their last game
- Pre-K – 2nd division teams will be responsible for securing a parent/volunteer to run the time clock. Referees will be provided for 3rd – 6th division games.
 - Please read the rules for your age division carefully.
 - Each team will be given practice equipment (a practice ball, whistle, stop watch & bag to hold these items) and be held responsible for returning all equipment at the end of the season. Game balls will be provided by Community Education.
 - The practice schedule will be available at the coach's meeting. Coaches will choose their practice night prior to the coach's meeting. If a player is selected for a coach's team, and their parent has indicated on the registration form that they absolutely cannot practice on that particular night, then we will switch that child with a child (of same gender, grade and ability ranking) on another team.
 - Coaches need to remain on the side-lines during each game. No exceptions!
